# Panoramic London Tour

# Oxford Tour

Oxford is an old university town. It is surrounded by rivers and canals, which makes walking around the city more fun. University buildings are located in most of the city, but the oldest and most important colleges are in the center of Oxford. During the tour we will visit the most famous of them. Let's get acquainted with their famous graduates: Margaret Thatcher, Hugh Grant, Kate Beckinsale, Rosamund Pike, Anthony Atkinson, Felicity Jones, Prince Yusupov, Prince Obolensky, Tony Blair, Yegor Konchalovsky, Boris Johnson. We will visit one of the largest aristocratic colleges - Christ Church College, famous for producing the largest number of prime ministers, as well as filming views from the Harry Potter movie.

You will visit the famous Ashmolin Museum known for its collection of Amati and Stradivari violins - "Messiah" in particular. Here is the oldest collection of rings, which served as the idea for writing the famous "Lord of the Rings" by Tolkien, here the unsolved theft of Cezan's painting took place on New Year's Eve 1999. Let's not ignore the most iconic Oxford student bar, the Purple Turtle, and the oldest, 11th century, Turf pub.

Also, You will visit the Alice shop, featured in the wonderful novel by Lewis Carroll, which is replete not only with Alice's favorite sweets, but also with souvenirs from the famous Looking Glass. Let's go under the Bridge of Sighs and find out why it is such. We will visit the local prison, which has slightly changed its incarnation today. We will visit the tavern where the Russian Emperor Peter stayed while visiting Oxford.



As part of the tour of Oxford, you will also be invited to visit the most interesting places in the city, such as the Kerfax Tower, which offers a picturesque panorama of the city, Magdalen College, whose high bell tower is visible from afar and is a symbol of the city.

# Cambridge Tour

# Royal Windsor Castle Tour

Also depending on the day and time of your visit, you might be lucky to witness the Changing of the Guard at Windsor Castle. The ceremony sees the guards marching through Windsor town and into the castle for the guard change.

# Leeds Castle, Canterbury Cathedral & Dover Tour

Journey into the heart of the English countryside as we visit the county of Kent, also known as the 'Garden of England' due to its lush rolling green hills, beautiful scenery and historic buildings. Visit the stunning Leeds Castle, the historic UNESCO World Heritage Site at Canterbury Cathedral and see the spectacular White Cliffs of Dover.

Often referred to as The Loveliest Castle in The World, Leeds Castle has played many roles in its nearly 900-year history. From a Norman stronghold to a magnificent royal palace, the castle today has been converted by subsequent owners into an idyllic countryside retreat.

Founded by St Augustine in 600 AD, the Cathedral today is one of the most excellent examples of Gothic architecture in England.

A designated UNESCO World Heritage Site, Canterbury Cathedral is both a serene place of holiness and beautiful tourist destination. As the Cathedral of the Archbishop, the spiritual leader of the Church of England, Canterbury holds a special place in English history.

In Dover we will have a view of the famous White Cliffs. Soaring 350 ft above the crashing waves of the English Channel, the White Cliffs of Dover are an instantly recognizable landmark of Britain. From Caesar to Shakespeare, some of history's most important figures recognized the towering symbolism of the cliffs.

# Southampton Port (to London Tour)

You will see the traditional place of the coronation of the monarchs of Great Britain and the burial places of the great people of England, the abbey is listed as a World Heritage Site (there are also Russian details in its architectural complex), the Clock Tower, on which the famous Big Ben bell is installed, is also part of it. Then, we will continue the tour with a short trip on the river clipper along the Thames.

You will see: Westminster Abbey, Big Ben (14-ton chimes), Parliament, St. James Park, Buckingham Palace, Trafalgar Square, National Gallery, City Hall, Tower Bridge, Tower Bridge, St. Katherine's Docks, Dickens Pub, Old City, St. Paul.
